



Part-time Teacher Job Description

Cambridge Nursery School is searching for a **MA EEC Teacher-qualified Part-time Teacher** to work as part of a team in our preschool classroom, beginning in the Fall, 2020. Candidates should be nurturing, friendly, knowledgeable about child development, responsible, creative, and enjoy working with young children. Applicants should feel comfortable to take initiative and appreciate the value of early childhood education and a play-based emergent curriculum. Children's happiness, safety, and sense of wonder are extremely important at Cambridge Nursery School; we seek to interview candidates who support our vision of a nurturing and inspiring learning community.

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, we will be limiting enrollment to one group of children. We will be following all mandated health and safety requirements. Cambridge Nursery School is housed in a recently renovated building with ample outdoor space and excellent ventilation.

Responsibilities:

- Engage with children in their play. Help children develop their language, social and emotional skills. Encourage problem solving in social interactions.
- Maintain a healthy, safe and secure classroom and school environment.
- Cooperate with teachers in preparing classroom activities.

Qualifications:

- At least 21 years of age.
- DEEC Teacher Qualification preferred: one course in Child Development.
- Work experience in a preschool setting; preschool co-op experience, a plus!
- B.A. in a related field helpful. Coursework in early childhood education, such as curriculum development, language development, behavior management, or special needs, helpful.
